ELECTIVE GUIDELINES FOR MBBS STUDENT BATCH 2022-23

An elective is an integral part of the Competency-Based Medical Education Curriculum. Elective posting is mandatory for all learners as per NMC. It is to be conducted after the exam of Third Professional Phase Part 1 and before the start of academic teaching for Third Professional Phase Part 2.

Objective: To provide an opportunity, where undergraduate medical student can explore their deeper interest areas, by working in a medical specialty in a hospital/ community setting or undertaking a project under an identified expert, which can be an important component in undergraduate medical education.

Method: One Month (30 days) is allotted for elective rotations (Block 1 & Block 2) after completion of the exam at the end of the MBBS Phase 3 Part I examination and before commencement of MBBS Phase 3 Part II.

Students of the **MBBS 2022-23 batch** will have their elective posting from **2nd to 31st January 2026**

Learners must do an elective. The protected time for electives should not be used to make up for missed clinical postings, shortage of attendance, or any other purpose. The learner will rotate through two elective blocks of 2 weeks each.

(a) **Block 1** shall be done in a pre-selected preclinical or para-clinical or other basic sciences laboratory.

(b) **Block 2** shall be done in a clinical department (including specialties, super-specialties, ICUs, blood banks, and casualty)

The learner must submit a learning log book based on both blocks of the elective.

75% attendance in each block of the electives and submission of log book maintained during elective is mandatory for eligibility to appear in the final MBBS examination.

Mechanism of allocation:

Elective choices (one for Block 1 and one for Block 2) will be allotted through counselling on 18.11.2025 according to rank (based on 2nd Professional MBBS Examination).

- There will be no theory classes and **clinical postings will only be during Block I elective Posting.**
